Operations Fee/ Uniforms/Clinics/Book/more...

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Dear Autrey Mill Band Family,

Welcome to the Autrey Mill Middle School Band program! The purpose of this letter is to outline various band needs/operations within our program that have expenses associated with them. Below you will find a description of each item. These items will cover many of the fees for the school year, so money is not being collected at each event unless it is beyond the descriptions below. **Please see the descriptions below and submit your payment through OSP (Online School Payments). All OSP links are provided on the AMMS Band website under the 'Band Online Payments' Tab.** All items listed MUST be paid by credit card through the online payment system.

## **BAND OPERATIONS FEE:**

We have a very active and successful band program and have been fortunate to provide our students with opportunities and experiences that extend beyond their daily classroom instruction. As you may know, we do not fundraise at AMMS to generate extra funds for general classroom activities that are an extension of our daily classroom activities. To continue this and to provide further opportunities and instruction to the students we have an **operations fee of \$100.00**. This will not nearly cover all the needs of the program, but it will greatly help. This one fee is in lieu of collecting fees throughout the year for various activities.

*Note: For returning students that already have uniforms, the operations fee goes more towards clinicians and events throughout the year.*

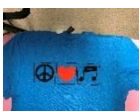
**This fee will pay for:**

- **Clinicians and Specialty Instructors for the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Gr. LGPE Band Clinic & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Start-Up Clinic** - One element of a comprehensive music education experience is giving the students opportunities to work with renowned conductors, musicians, and performers. This contribution will help to offset the cost of bringing in such esteemed musicians.
- **Instrument specialists** – Small group instruction periodically throughout the year, start-up days, and instrument testing.
- **LGPE Fees** – Entry fees for group participation in LGPE. Fees can range from \$170 - \$195 per ensemble.
- **Music, Method Resources, and Specialty Ensemble Music (individuals and small groups)** - The cost of one band piece is between \$50 and \$100 (Some advanced pieces are even more expensive). This contribution will allow us to continue building a music library that meets the educational needs of the students.
- **Uniforms: There are 2 uniform shirts needed for ALL students.** Our first concert will be right around the corner before we know it. As well as entertaining our audience and playing to the best of our ability, we also want to look great. Our performance attire will help us to do just that.



## **FORMAL POLO:**

The formal polo shirt uniform is both classic and formal which includes black pants and a white polo shirt. A black and white uniform will present a clean appearance and provide more uniformity within the group. **The entire formal band uniform consists of a white polo shirt with an embroidered logo, black pants, black socks, black belt, and black shoes. The band shirt should be able to be tucked in for performances.** Uniform pants may be purchased through a store of your choice. Please refer to the band handbook for more information.



## **CASUAL PEACE-LOVE-MUSIC:**

The casual uniform is our music department peace-love-music t-shirt. We will use this for more informal concerts during the year, spirit wear days, trips, school performances, etc. The T-shirt will be worn with jeans.

Other optional band spirit wear may be available at a later time.

Please make your uniform purchase now. You don't want to be running around at the last minute trying to find pants or shoes. The uniform shirts will be ordered through the school. Orders should arrive during the month of October.

**PARENTS:** It is extremely important for your child to have the proper uniform. JEANS, SHORTS and TENNIS SHOES are not acceptable formal performance attire. Students may be asked not to participate if dressed inappropriately. I appreciate your help with this. - **Method Books & Binder System**

Each grade level has a different method book they will use for warm-ups, etudes, technique exercises, and rhythm exercises etc. that are appropriate for their level of instruction. These books will also be supplemented with other books and exercises in class. To assist with obtaining these method books, I will place a school order so we can receive them all at the same time and for your convenience. Below are the titles for the method books for each grade level. Students will also have a black 3 ring binder, dividers, and 3 sheet protectors to start their binder system.
