- ♦ 1 empty 35 mm film case/medicine bottle/small Tupperware for water to soak reeds

CLARINETS:

- ♦ Three Four working reeds at all times. (Vandoren Reeds 2 (6th gr. Only) or 2 ½ / 3 strength)
- ♦ (Clarinet) Vandoren 5RV Lyre mouthpiece, B45, or M13; Larry Coumbs LC3, Educator G*
- Model 2600 (Hard rubber); Ligatures: Bonade or Rovner
- (Bass Clarinet) Vandoren B45 mouthpiece
- Bonade inverted ligature
- Plastic Reed Holder Holds 4 reeds
- <u>Clear</u> mouthpiece patches
- Cork Grease, Cleaning Swab & Cleaning Cloth

SAXOPHONES:

Recommended Saxophone Brands and Models: Cannonball, P. Mauriat, Selmer, Yamaha

- Three Four working reeds at all times. Vandoren Reeds, 2 (6th gr. Only) or 2 ½ or 3 strength
- Rousseau (5R facing) or Selmer C* mouthpiece
- Rovner or Bonade Ligature
- Plastic Reed Holder Holds 4 reeds
- <u>Clear</u> mouthpiece patches
- Neck Strap
- ♦ Cork Grease, Cleaning Swab & Cleaning Cloth
- ♦ Bari Sax Harness Body/Neck Strap

TRUMPETS, FRENCH HORNS, BARITONES, AND TUBAS

Recommended Trumpet Brands and Models: Bach, King, Getzen, S.E. Shires, Yamaha

Recommended Horn Brands and Models (MUST BE A DOUBLE HORN): Conn, Holton, Yamaha

Recommended Baritone Brands and Models: Yamaha, Eastman, King, S.E. Shires

Recommended Tuba Brands and Models: Yamaha, Bach, King

Donation Items: If time and family finances allow, the AMMS Band is always grateful for donations of the following items:

It is strongly suggested that students who play instruments requiring reeds to buy reeds by the box. This is much more economical and convenient than running to the store every time one breaks (and they WILL break....frequently.)

Double Reeds (Oboe/Bassoon) – Handmade reeds are preferred. See Mrs. Smith for how to order.

Advanced wind instrument players are also encouraged to obtain step-up mouthpieces for their instruments. Such mouthpieces will show great improvement in the quality of sound produced by the students and is an appealing option when compared to the cost of purchasing a new instrument. A beginner instrument will often sound very similar to a professional model when outfitted with a step-up mouthpiece. Step-up mouthpieces are listed by instrument. If you are interested in purchasing a more advanced instrument, Mrs. Smith can assist you with more information. Please call ahead to be certain your items are in stock before making a trip to the store.

<u>Please note:</u> When more advanced instruments are purchased, the beginner model could be kept for later use in marching band.

Uniform shirts will be ordered early in the year. All students must have a uniform to perform.

- Mouthpiece (Mouthpieces are not included with school instrument rentals) Trumpet: Bach 5C (6th gr.) or 3C mouthpiece (Not a 7C) French Horn: King H2, Conn H2, or Schilke 30 mouthpiece
 - Baritone: Bach $6 \frac{1}{2}$ AL (6^{th} gr.) mouthpiece, Yamaha 48 or Schilke 51
 - Tuba: Bach 18 or Bach 24AW or Conn Helleberg 7B mouthpiece
- Valve oil & Slide grease
- Polishing Cloth, Mouthpiece Brush & Cleaning Snake

TROMBONES:

Recommended Brands: Yamaha, Jupiter, Getzen, Conn, Bach, S. E. Shires

- Mouthpiece *small shank
- Bach 6 1/2AL (6th gr.) mouthpiece, Yamaha 48 or Schilke 51
- Mouthpiece Brush, Polishing Cloth & Cleaning Snake
- Slide Cream Slide-o-Mix (for slide lubrication)
- Small spray bottle with water

The option is yours, but I highly suggest that you **rent and not buy** when first getting started. Students will start on a beginner model and will likely need to upgrade to an intermediate or professional model as they progress as a musician. Most stores have a policy that if you want to upgrade an instrument during your rental period then they will transfer rental payments to the new instrument. Upgraded instruments may be needed in two or three years depending on how your child progresses and as they "outgrow" the instrument.

Rent or buy a quality instrument. Beware of the inexpensive "all inclusive," music sets from Amazon, Walmart, or Target. Most people wouldn't trust a car that comes from the same store where you can buy toilet paper and groceries. Instruments are the same! Inexpensive instruments break easily and usually spend more time in the shop than in the classroom with your child. When buying from the internet, there is no guarantee of what you are getting or the condition. Please use caution. When you purchase through a music store, often they have contracts that will repair your instrument for free while you are renting and/or give you a loaner while yours is being repaired. This is your best option. If you do have to buy a used instrument, have it checked by a music repairman to make sure it is in good condition. A properly working instrument is key to your child's success.

Tubas, Euphoniums, Bassoons and Horns: These instruments may be more limited for rentals or nonexistent for rentals at stores. We have a very limited number of instruments available for rent from the school and these will be offered based on instrument selection, need, and availability.

School Rentals and Percussion: If school instruments are available, an AMMS Instrument Rental Form will be included with your instrument documents. A rental fee applies, and can be paid for through OSP. Students will still need to provide other supplies such as mouthpieces, method book, cleaning kits, etc. All percussionists will use their own set of mallets as well as class owned instruments such as auxiliary instruments, bass drum, timpani, chimes, etc. There is a Percussion Usage Fee for use of the classroom equipment (larger equipment such as timpani, bass drum, chimes, etc. that remain in the band room) and to assist with maintenance of these instruments. If your child has been selected for percussion, this form will be sent home. Percussion Usage Fee can be paid via OSP.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT FOR AMMS PERCUSSIONISTS

- Set of Bells & Snare Drum These will be kept at home for home practice unless instructed to be brought to school. Percussionists will play all percussion instruments including mallets, timpani, snare, cymbals, "toys", etc. No one will play only snare. We will create well-rounded percussionists, not drummers.
- Sticks and mallets of various types: Just as woodwind and brass players rent an instrument, purchase upgraded instruments, replace reeds and/or upgrade their mouthpieces, percussionists use a variety of types of instruments that use a variety of types of mallets and sticks. A list of equipment needed to build a standard stick bag is below.
- A school equipment usage fee will be assessed to each percussionist for the use of classroom equipment. This fee will help to maintain the instruments used in the classroom or will be put towards the purchase of new equipment. The fee is \$70 each year.
